

Derbyshire Mining Customs and Mineral Courts Act 1852

1852 CHAPTER clxiii 16 and 17 Vict

V Saving Rights of C. Clarke.

Nothing in this Act contained shall be construed to alter or affect any Right which Charles Clarke, the present Barmaster of the Soke and Wapentake of Wirksworth, may have to appoint the Steward of the Barmote Courts within the said Soke and Wapentake, or to alter or affect any other Right or Privilege of the said Charles Clarkeas such Barmaster as aforesaid, so long as he shall continue to hold the said Office of Barmaster.
