



CHAPTER clv.

An Act for extending the time for completing the Works for improving the Outfall of the River Witham in the County of Lincoln authorised by the River Witham Outfall Improvement Act 1880. [6th August 1885.]

A.D. 1885.

WHEREAS by the River Witham Outfall Improvement Act 1880 (herein-after referred to as "the recited Act") the Witham Outfall Board (herein-after referred to as "the Board") was incorporated and authorised to make or form a new cut or channel and to execute the other works therein described for improving the outfall and channel of the River Witham and incidental thereto:

And whereas the period limited by the recited Act for the completion of the said works expires on the sixth day of August one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five and the Board have constructed a considerable portion of the said works but they will be unable to complete the same within such period and it is expedient that the said period be extended as herein-after provided:

And whereas the object aforesaid cannot be attained without the authority of Parliament:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the River Witham Outfall Improvement (Extension of Time) Act 1885.

Short title of Act.

2. The period limited by the recited Act for the completion of the works thereby authorised to be constructed and the powers by that Act granted to the Board for executing the same are hereby extended to the sixth day of August one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven which shall be deemed to have been the period limited by the recited Act for the completion of the said works and on the

Period for completion of works authorised by the recited Act extended.

(*Extension of Time*) Act, 1885.

A.D. 1885. — expiration of such extended period the powers granted to the Board for making those respective works or otherwise in relation thereto shall cease to be exercised except as to so much thereof as shall have been then completed.

Costs of Act. **3.** All costs charges and expenses preliminary to and of and incidental to the preparing and applying for and the obtaining and passing of this Act or otherwise in relation thereto shall be paid by the Board as part of the expenses incurred in the execution of works under the recited Act.
