CHAPTER Ixiv.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order made by the Local Government Board for Ireland under the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 relating to the Urban Sanitary District of Dublin. A.D. 1895.
[27th June 1895.]

WHEREAS the Local Government Board for Ireland have made the Provisional Order set forth in the schedule hereto under the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878:

And whereas it is requisite that the said Order should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Order set out in the schedule hereto is hereby confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity and force.

DUBLIN WATERWORKS.

PROVISIONAL ORDER.

WHEREAS the Right Honourable the Lord Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of Dublin acting as the town council (herein-after called the sanitary authority) are about to construct a new reservoir and other works to be used for collecting and storing water in addition to the storage reservoir for collecting and storing the water of the river Vartry in the county Wicklow constructed in pursuance of the Dublin Corporation Waterworks Act 1861 and the several acts altering and amending the said Act and have presented a petition to the Local Government Board for Ireland (herein-after called the Local Government Board) in pursuance of the provisions of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 praying that they may be allowed to put in force the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement with reference to certain lands and premises required for the purposes of the said additional storage reservoir and other works :

And whereas the sanitary authority have deposited at the office of the Local Government Board in Dublin plans and a book of reference (herein-after called the deposited plans and book of reference) showing the lands and premises required for the purposes of the said additional storage reservoir and other works :

And whereas all advertisements and notices required by the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 having been previously published served and given the Local Government Board have caused a local inquiry to be held as to the propriety of assenting to the prayer of the said petition and it appears to the Local Government Board to be proper to assent thereto :

1. From and after the confirmation of this Order by Parliament the sanitary authority shall be empowered to put in force the powers of the Lands Clauses Acts with respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement with reference to the lands and premises shown and described in the said deposited plans and book of reference and the provisions contained in Sections 39 to 42 both inclusive of the Dublin Corporation Waterworks Act 1861 relating to the harbour of Wicklow and the channel thereof shall extend to and include all works and operations of the sanitary authority to be executed in pursuance of this Order.
