## GULIELMI IV. REGIS.

Cap. xiv.

An Act to enable the Commissioner appointed under Two Acts for draining certain Lands situated on or near the River Leven in the Counties of Kinross and Fife to raise a further Sum of Money for the Purposes of the said Acts.

[12th June 1835.]

HEREAS an Act was passed in the Seventh and Eighth Years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled An Act for recovering, draining, and 7 & 8 G. 4. preserving certain Lands in the Parishes of Kinross, Orwell, and c. 105. Portmoak in the County of Kinross, and in the Parishes of Ballingry, Auchterderran, and Kinglassie in the County of Fife; and for the better supplying with Water the Mills, Manufactories, Bleachfields, and other Works situated on or near the River of Leven in the said County of Fife: And whereas another Act was passed in the Second Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled An Act to amend and extend 1 & 2 W.4. the Powers of an Act for recovering, draining, and preserving certain c. 10. Lands, and for better supplying with Water the Mills, Manufactories, and other Works situated on the River Leven, in the Counties of Kinross and Fife; by which last-mentioned Act Authority was given to raise a further Sum of Money: And whereas the whole Works authorized by the said recited Acts have been completed; but, owing to the increased Extent of the Damages and Expence incurred in the Completion thereof beyond what was calculated upon when the said lastrecited Act was obtained, the Sums authorized to be levied under the [Local.]

said recited Acts have been found insufficient to discharge all the Costs and Expences attending the Completion of the said Undertaking, and it is expedient and necessary that a further Sum of Money should be raised for that Purpose; but the same cannot be accomplished without the Aid and Authority of Parliament: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, Provisions of That the said Two recited Acts, and all the Powers, Provisions, Authorities, Regulations, Matters, and Things therein contained (except in so far as the same are hereby altered, varied, and repealed), shall continue in full Force and Effect, and shall be as good, valid, and effectual for carrying this Act into execution as if the same had been repeated in the Body of this Act.

recited Acts extended to this Act, except as hereby repealed.

Additional Sum to be raised.

II. And be it enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the Commissioner acting under the Authority of the said recited Acts, or his Successors in Office, and he and they is and are hereby authorized and empowered to raise by Assessment or Assessments a further Sum not exceeding Eight thousand four hundred and twenty Pounds, with the legal Interest thereof from the First Day of January One thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, which Sum to be raised shall be assessed and levied and expended in the Manner and under the Provisions of the said Two recited Acts.

Expence of to be paid.

III. And be it enacted, That the Expence of applying for and passing this Act shall be defrayed from the Funds to be raised under the Authority of this Act.

Public Act.

IV. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be deemed and taken to be a Public Act, and shall be judicially taken notice of as such by all Judges, Justices, and others.
