

## CHAPTER 10

An Act to make further provision as respects the application of certain funds under the management of the Royal Patriotic Fund Corporation.

[12th Tuly 1950.]

DE it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1.—(1) The objects of the fund constituted in pursuance of Extension of subsection (2) of section ten of the Regimental Debts Act, 1893 objects of (which provides for the application of the undisposed residue of soldiers' effects oldiers' effects to the creation or maintenance of a fund for fund. the benefit of widows or children, or other near relatives, of 56 & 57 Vict. soldiers dying on service or within six months after discharge) c. 5. shall, to such extent as may be provided by Royal Warrant under that Act and subject to the provisions of any such Warrant, include the widows, children and other near relatives of persons dying at any time who have been soldiers.

- (2) The foregoing subsection shall apply in relation to the air force, but with the substitution—
  - (a) for the reference to the said Act of 1893 of a reference to that Act as applied to the air force;
  - (b) for the references to soldiers of references to airmen.

3. This Act may be cited as the Royal Patriotic Fund Corporation Act, 1950.
