### **1963 CHAPTER 37**

#### PART I

CARE AND CONTROL OF CHILDREN AND YOUNG PERSONS

Juvenile courts and proceedings in connection with children and young persons

#### Medical evidence by certificate.

In any proceedings, other than proceedings for an offence, before a [FIyouth court], and on any appeal from a decision of a [FIyouth court] in any such proceedings, any document purporting to be a certificate of a fully registered medical practitioner [F2who holds a licence to practise] as to any person's physical or mental condition shall be admissible as evidence of that condition.
