#### MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS FOR PURCHASE OF EXHIBITS

##### *Power of investment*

- 5 Income arising from investments made under paragraph 4 above shall be carried to the county fund [<sup>F1</sup>council fund] or the [<sup>F2</sup>general fund or, in the case of the common council, the City fund], as the case may be, and an equivalent sum shall be paid from that fund into the art fund.
