1966 CHAPTER 36

Registration and qualification for registration

[^{F1}5B Registration of Community rights entitled persons: knowledge and skill

- (1) A person who is a Community rights entitled person is entitled to be registered in the register if—
- the person is not entitled under section 5A of this Act to be registered;
 - the person's case falls within regulation 3(9)(a) or (e) of the [^{F2}European Union] (Recognition of Professional Qualifications) Regulations 2007;
 - regulations 20 to 26 of those Regulations apply to the person by reason of the operation of regulation 3(4) of those Regulations; and
 - the person is permitted to pursue the profession of veterinary surgeon in the United Kingdom by virtue of Part 3 of those Regulations (having, in particular, successfully completed any adaptation period, or passed any aptitude test, that the person may be required to undertake pursuant to that Part of those Regulations).
- (2) A person shall become a member of the College on being registered under this section.]
