1966 CHAPTER 36

Registration and qualification for registration

[F1 F25ZRAquirement to demonstrate knowledge of language

- (1) This section applies where
 - the registrar has a serious and concrete doubt about whether a person has a knowledge of language sufficient to practise as a veterinary surgeon in the United Kingdom, as mentioned in F3... section 6(1)(d); F4...
 - F4(b)
- (2) The registrar may
 - require the person to demonstrate that that person has a knowledge of language sufficient to practise as a veterinary surgeon in the United Kingdom; and
 - refuse to register that person in the register until that person has done so.]]
