## 1966 CHAPTER 42

### PART IV

#### MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

#### 40 Orders, regulations and rules.

- (1) Any power conferred on a Minister by this Act to make an order, . . . <sup>F1</sup> shall be exercisable by statutory instrument.
- (2) An order under any provision of this Act, . . . <sup>F1</sup>, may be revoked or varied by a subsequent order under that provision.
- (3) Any statutory instrument containing . . . <sup>F1</sup> an order under section . . . <sup>F2</sup>, . . . <sup>F1</sup>, 35 . . . <sup>F3</sup> of this Act shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
