

## Protection of Birds Act 1967

## **1967 CHAPTER 46**

## 1 Extension of protection for lapwing eggs

- (1) The prohibition imposed by section 6(1) of the Protection of Birds Act 1954 (in this Act referred to as "the principal Act") on a person's selling, offering for sale or having in his possession for sale, and by section 7(1) of that Act on the importation of, the eggs of a lapwing, save as may be authorised by a licence granted under section 10 of that Act, shall, instead of being limited to the period in any year after 14th April, have effect throughout the year; and accordingly in that Act section 6(l)(iii), in section 7(l) (c) the words "on or after the fifteenth day of April in any year "and section 9(4) (c) and (d) are hereby repealed.
- (2) In this section any reference to sale shall be construed as including a reference to barter and exchange.
