



Protection of Birds Act 1967

1967 CHAPTER 46

1 Extension of protection for lapwing eggs

- (1) The prohibition imposed by section 6(1) of the Protection of Birds Act 1954 (in this Act referred to as "the principal Act") on a person's selling, offering for sale or having in his possession for sale, and by section 7(1) of that Act on the importation of, the eggs of a lapwing, save as may be authorised by a licence granted under section 10 of that Act, shall, instead of being limited to the period in any year after 14th April, have effect throughout the year ; and accordingly in that Act section 6(1)(iii), in section 7(1) (c) the words " on or after the fifteenth day of April in any year " and section 9(4) (c) and (d) are hereby repealed.
- (2) In this section any reference to sale shall be construed as including a reference to barter and exchange.
