# Offences

# 89 False written statements tendered in evidence.

- (1) If any person in a written statement tendered in evidence in criminal proceedings by virtue of section. . . <sup>F1</sup> 9 of this Act [<sup>F2</sup>[F3 or in proceedings before a court-martial by virtue of the said section 9 as extended by section 12 above or by section 99A of the M1 Army Act 1955 or section 99A of the M2 Air Force Act 1955]] wilfully makes a statement material in those proceedings which he knows to be false or does not believe to be true, he shall be liable on conviction on indictment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or a fine or both.
- (2) The M3Perjury Act 1911 shall have effect as if this section were contained in that Act.
