# **1967 CHAPTER 86**

## PART V

#### GENERAL, FINANCIAL AND SUPPLEMENTARY

#### 74 Expenses.

- (1) The Secretary of State may pay such sums in respect of the expenses of [<sup>F1</sup>Scottish Natural Heritage] as he may, with the consent of the Treasury, determine.
- (2) There shall be paid out of moneys provided by Parliament-
  - (a) any expenses incurred by the Secretary of State under this Act; and
  - (b) any increase in the sums payable out of moneys so provided under any enactment relating to local government in Scotland or under the <sup>M1</sup>Forestry Act 1967.
