## 1968 CHAPTER 18

*Privileges and immunities in connection with Commonwealth and Irish establishments*

### 15 Validation of certain provisions in colonial laws.

Notwithstanding anything in the <sup>M1</sup>Colonial Laws Validity Act 1865, no colonial law within the meaning of that Act shall be void or inoperative as being repugnant to the <sup>M2</sup>Admiralty Offences (Colonial) Act 1849, the <sup>M3</sup>Territorial Waters Jurisdiction Act 1878 or section <sup>F1</sup>280 or section 281 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995] by reason only of making provision corresponding to section 5 of this Act.
