#### TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

##### *Interpretation*

- 9 In this Schedule the following expressions have the meanings assigned to them—
- “approved school” means a school approved under section 83 of the <sup>M1</sup>Children and Young Persons (Scotland) Act 1937.
  - “approved school order” has the meaning assigned to it by section 110(1) of the said Act of 1937.
  - “remand home” has the meaning assigned to it by section 78(1) of the <sup>M2</sup>Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 1949.
  - “supervision order” has the meaning assigned to it by section 72 of the said Act of 1949.
