STAMPS AND STAMP DUTIES

Special Provisions with respect to Northern Ireland

128 Application of foregoing provisions of Part VI to Northern Ireland.

In the application of the foregoing provisions of this Part of this Act to Northern Ireland:—

- (a) ^{F1}
- (b) for any reference to Great Britain there shall be substituted a reference to Northern Ireland;
- (c) any reference (except in sections 117 and 122) to the ^{M1}Stamp Duties Management Act 1891 or to the ^{M2}Stamp Act 1891 shall be construed as a reference to that Act as it applies to stamp duties chargeable in Northern Ireland or to stamps which may denote any such duties, as the case may require;
- (d) ^{F1}
- (e) ^{F2}
