CHAPTER 56

AUCTIONS (BIDDING AGREEMENTS) ACT 1969

- 1 Offences under Auctions (Bidding Agreements) Act 1927 to be indictable as well as triable summarily, and extension of time for bringing summary proceedings.
- 2 Persons convicted not to attend or participate in auctions.
- 3 Rights of seller of goods by auction where agreement subsists that some person shall abstain from bidding for the goods.
- 4 Copy of Act to be exhibited at sale.
- 5 Short title, commencement and extent.
