



Fishing Vessels (Safety Provisions) Act 1970

1970 CHAPTER 27

2 Fishing vessel survey rules.

- (1) The Board of Trade may make rules (in this Act referred to as “fishing vessel survey rules”) for the surveying and periodical inspection of fishing vessels registered in the United Kingdom, or any description of such fishing vessels, for the purposes of ensuring their compliance with the requirements of the fishing vessel construction rules, the rules for life-saving appliances, the radio rules, the rules for direction-finders [^{F1}and the rules for radio navigational aids]^{F1}, the rules for radio navigational aids and sections 1 and 2 of the Safety at Sea Act 1986 (safety requirements for fishing vessels)] applicable to them.
- (2) Section 275 of the ^{M1}Merchant Shipping Act 1894 (appeals to the court of survey) shall apply to surveys carried out under the fishing vessel survey rules with such modifications as may be prescribed by the rules.
