Legal consequences of termination of contract to marry

- 1 Engagements to marry not enforceable at law
- 2 Property of engaged couples
- 3 Gifts between engaged couples

Damages for adultery

4 Abolition of right to claim damages for adultery

Enticement of spouse, etc.

5 Abolition of actions for enticement, seduction and harbouring of spouse or child

Maintenance for survivor of void marriage

Orders for maintenance of surviving party to void marriage from estate of other party
