

# Fire Precautions Act 1971 (repealed)

## **1971 CHAPTER 40**

Consultation between fire and other authorities

# Duty of fire authorities to consult other authorities before requiring alterations to buildings.

- (1) Before a [F1appropriate authority][F2fire and rescue authority]—
  - (a) serve on the applicant for a fire certificate with respect to any premises a notice under section 5(4) of this Act informing him that they will not issue a certificate unless alterations are made to the relevant building; or
  - (b) serve in respect of any premises a notice under section 8(4) or (5) [F3, section 9D] or section 12(8)(b) of this Act mentioning as a step which would have to be taken [F3 or, in the case of a notice under section 9D, which must be taken] anything involving the making of alterations to the relevant building,

# the authority shall—

- (i) if the premises are situated in England or Wales . . . and the  $[^{F1}$ appropriate authority] $[^{F2}$ fire and rescue authority] are not the local authority for the area in which the premises are situated, consult that local authority; . . .  $^{F4}$
- (ii) if the premises are situated in Scotland, consult the [F5]local] authority (within the meaning of . . . F6 the Building (Scotland) Act [F72003 (asp 8)]) for the area in which the premises are situated, [F8 and]
- [F9(iii) if the premises are used as a place of work and are within the field of responsibility of one or more enforcing authorities within the meaning of Part I of the MI Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974, consult that authority or each of those authorities.]
- (2) For the avoidance of doubt it is hereby declared that a local authority [F10 buildings authority or other authority] who have in accordance with this section been consulted by a [F1 appropriate authority] [F11 fire and rescue authority] proposing to serve any such notice as is mentioned in subsection (1) above may be a person aggrieved within the meaning of section 9 of this Act.
