A pension payable by [^{F1}a police and crime commissioner, the Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime, a chief constable established under section 2 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis or] a police authority under regulations made under section 60(2) of the ^{M1}Local Government Act 1958, section 85(4) of the ^{M2}London Government Act 1963 or section 4 of the ^{M3}Public Expenditure and Receipts Act 1968 (compensation for loss of employment or emoluments due to reorganisation of local government etc). [^{F2}or under regulations made under section 24 of the ^{M4}Superannuation Act 1972 (further provisions requiring payment of compensation for loss of employment, etc.).
