## PENSIONS OUT OF LOCAL FUNDS

## Court and police staffs

- 47 A pension payable by a local authority in England or Wales under any enactment other than section 15(1) to (7) of the <sup>MI</sup>Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1967 in respect of—
  - (a) service as a justices' clerk or as the employee of a justices' clerk; or
  - (b) service as a person employed by a magistrates' courts committee to assist a justices' clerk.



- (b) service as a traffic warden employed by such a police authority under section 2 of the M4Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act 1960 or section 81(9) of the <sup>M5</sup>Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 [<sup>F5</sup>section 95(1)] of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.]
