# A pension payable (otherwise than as mentioned in paragraph 14 or 15 above) under any of the following;— (a) [FI the MI Police Pensions Act 1976, or any enactment repealed by the MI Police Pensions Act 1948] or by the MI Police Pensions Act 1921; [FI to section 51 or 52 of the Police Act 1996;] (c) section 26 or 27 of the MI Police (Scotland) Act 1967. This paragraph does not include a derivative pension other than a substituted pension, nor a substituted pension if the original pension was a derivative pension.
