DIPLOMATIC AND OTHER PRIVILEGES ACT 1971

- 1 Refund of customs duty on hydrocarbon oil used for diplomatic or Commonwealth Secretariat purposes.
- 2 Power to grant privileges etc. in case of Caribbean Development Bank.
- 3 Exemption from vehicle excise duty of senior officers of U.N. agencies.
- 4 Privileges and immunities in connection with Commonwealth and Irish posts of a consular nature.
