PART I

PRINCIPAL ROAD SAFETY PROVISIONS

Offences connected with riding of pedal cycles

18 Careless, and inconsiderate, cycling

If a person rides a cycle, not being a motor vehicle, on a road without due care and attention, or without reasonable consideration for other persons using the road, he shall be guilty of an offence.

In this section "road" includes a bridleway.
