Social Work (Scotland) Act 1972

1972 CHAPTER 24

An Act to amend section 30 of the Social Work (Scotland) [11th May 1972] Act 1968.

E IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. In Part III of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 (children Jurisdiction in need of compulsory measures of care), in section 30 (definition of children's of child, etc.) there shall be added the following subsection—

hearing where child attains

"(3) Where a child attains the age of sixteen years after age of 16 the date on which a children's hearing first sit to consider years after his case, but before the date of the conclusion of the ment of proceedings on his case, the provisions of this Part of this hearing, Act and of any statutory instrument made thereunder shall 1968 c. 49. continue to apply to him in relation to that case as if he had not attained that age."

2. This Act may be cited as the Social Work (Scotland) Act Citation. 1972, and the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 and this Act may be cited together as the Social Work (Scotland) Acts 1968 and 1972.
