#### AMENDMENTS OF OTHER ENACTMENTS

The Nursing Homes Registration (Scotland) Act 1938

- 71 In section 1 (registration), the following amendments shall be made—
  - (a) in subsection (2), for the words " local authority" there shall be substituted the words " Health Board ", and for the words " a fee of £1 " there shall be substituted the words " such fee as may be so prescribed ";
  - (b) in subsection (3), for the words "local authority" and "authority" there shall be substituted respectively the words "Health Board "and "Board".
- In sections 2 and 3 (cancellation of registration and notification thereof), for the words " local authority " and " authority ", wherever they occur, there shall be substituted respectively the words " Health Board " and " Board ".
- At the end of section 4(1) (regulations), there shall be added the following words—

"and

- (d) with respect to such matters as appear to be expedient in order to secure continuity between the system of registration by local authorities and the system of registration by Health Boards.".
- In section 5(1) (inspection of nursing homes), for the words from the beginning to " made by the authority " there shall be substituted the words " Any medical officer, qualified nurse or other officer of the Health Board duly authorised by the Board ".
- In section 6 (power to exempt certain institutions), for the words " local authority " and " authority", wherever they occur, there shall be substituted respectively the words " Health Board " and " Board ".
