Conduct of reviews

61 Local inquiries.

- (1) [^{F1}The Welsh Commission or a][^{F2}Welsh principal] council may cause a local inquiry to be held with respect to any review carried out by them under this Part of this Act.
- (2) Section 250(2), (3) and (5) below shall apply in relation to an inquiry held under this section with the substitution for references to a Minister of references to the Commission or [^{F2}Welsh principal] council causing the inquiry to be held.
