MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

[F132 Punishment for use of premises in breach of closing order.

In section 2791) of the MI Housing Act 1957 (which prescribes the maximum punishment for the use of premises in breach of a closing order) for the words "twenty pounds" there shall be substituted the words "£100"; and for the words "five pounds" there shall in relation to any day after the coming into force of this section be substituted the words "£20"]
