Visiting forces

3 In the ^{M2}Visiting Forces (British Commonwealth) Act 1933, section 4 (attachment and mutual powers of command) shall apply in relation to forces raised in the Bahamas as it applies to forces raised in Dominions within the meaning of the ^{M3}Statute of Westminster 1931.

4 In the ^{M4}Visiting Forces Act 1952—
(a) in section 1(1)(a) (countries to which the Act applies) at the end there shall be added the words “the Bahamas or”;
(b) in section 10(1)(a), the expression “colony” shall not include the Bahamas;

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and, until express provision with respect to the Bahamas is made by an Order in Council under section 8 of that Act (application to visiting forces of law relating to home forces), any such Order for the time being in force shall be deemed to apply to visiting forces of the Bahamas.

5 In section 427(2) of the ^{M5}Merchant Shipping Act 1894, as set out in section 2 of the ^{M6}Merchant Shipping (Safety Convention) Act 1949, before the words “or in any” there shall be inserted the words “or the Bahamas”.

Colonial stock

9 Section 20 of the ^{M8}Colonial Stock Act 1877 (which relates to the jurisdiction of courts in the United Kingdom as to colonial stock) shall, in its application to stock of the Bahamas, have effect as if for the second paragraph there were substituted—

“(2) Any person claiming to be interested in colonial stock to which this Act applies, or in any dividend thereon, may institute civil proceedings in the United Kingdom against the registrar in relation to that stock or dividend.

(3) Notwithstanding anything in the foregoing provisions of this section, the registrar shall not by virtue of an order made by any court in the United Kingdom in any such proceedings as are referred to in this section be liable to make any payment otherwise than out of moneys in his possession in the United Kingdom as registrar.”

Commonwealth Institute

10 In section 8(2) of the ^{M9}Imperial Institute Act 1925, as amended by the ^{M10}Commonwealth Institute Act 1958, (power to vary the provisions of the said Act of 1925 if an agreement for the purpose is made with the governments of certain territories which for the time being are contributing towards the expenses of the Commonwealth Institute) at the end there shall be added the words “and the Bahamas”.
