

Land Compensation (Scotland) Act 1973

1973 CHAPTER 56

PART VI

SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS

80 General interpretation.

(1) In this Act—

"agriculture", "agricultural" and "agricultural land" have the meaning given in section 86 of the MIAgriculture (Scotland) Act 1948, and references to the farming of land include references to the carrying on in relation to the land of any agricultural activities;

"agricultural holding" has the meaning given in section 1 of the [F1Agricultural Holdings (Scotland) Act 1991] and "landlord", "tenant" and "notice to quit", in relation to an agricultural holding, have the same meaning as in that Act;

"agricultural unit" has the meaning given in section 196(1) of the M2Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1972;

"acquiring authority", and "authority possessing compulsory purchase powers" have the same meaning as in the M3Land Compensation (Scotland) Act 1963;

[F2"aerodrome" has the same meaning as in the Civil Aviation Act 1982;]
[F3"carriageway" has the same meaning as in the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984]

"cottar" has the same meaning as in section 28(4) of the M4Crofters (Scotland) Act 1955;

"croft", "crofter" and "landlord", in relation to a croft, have the same meanings respectively as in the Crofters (Scotland) Act 1955;

"disabled person" means a person in need under section 12 of the M5 Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 as read with section 1 of the M6 Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons (Scotland) Act 1972;

"dwelling" means a building or part of a building occupied or (if not occupied) last occupied or intended to be occupied as a private house, and (except in section 27) includes any garden, yard, outhouses and appurtenances belonging to or usually enjoyed with that building or part;

"heritable security" means any security capable of being constituted over any interest in land by a disposition or assignation of that interest in security of any debt and of being recorded in the Register of Sasines;

"holding", in relation to a landholder and a statutory small tenant, has the same meaning as in section 2(1) of the MTSmall Landholders (Scotland) Act 1911 and "landlord", in relation to such a holding, has the same meaning as in the MSAgricultural Holdings (Scotland) Act 1949;

[F4"housing association" has the meaning assigned to it by [F5 the Housing Associations Act 1985];]

"landholder" has the same meaning as in section 2(2) of the Small Landholders (Scotland) Act 1911;

"Lands Tribunal" means the Lands Tribunal for Scotland;

[F6" local roads authority" has the same meaning as in the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984]

"owner" has the same meaning as in section 45(1) of the M9Land Compensation (Scotland) Act 1963;

[F4" registered", in relation to a housing association, means registered [F7 under the Housing Associations Act 1985];]

[F8' road" has the same meaning as in the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;]

[F9" roads authority" has the same meaning as in the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;]

"statutory small tenant" has the same meaning as in section 32(1) of the Small Landholders (Scotland) Act 1911.
