PART I

ENACTMENTS OF PARLIAMENT OF UNITED KINGDOM

The Industrial Injuries and Diseases (Old Cases) Act 1967

- In section 9 of the Old Cases Act, after subsection (2) add the following—
 - "(3) Any sum due from a person by virtue of any provision made by or under this Act may be recovered from him by reduction of any payment under this Act or from benefit under the Social Security Act 1973 or Part II of the Industrial Injuries Act."
- In section 14(1) of that Act in the definition of "prescribed "for "insured persons employed in insurable employment" substitute "earners employed in employed earner's employment".
