

Education (Mentally Handicapped Children) (Scotland) Act 1974

1974 CHAPTER 27

An Act to make provision as respects Scotland for discontinuing the ascertainment of mentally handicapped children as unsuitable for education at school, to impose a duty on education authorities to provide for the education of such children whether accommodated in a hospital within the meaning of the Mental Health (Scotland) Act 1960 or otherwise, and for purposes connected therewith. [17th July 1974]
