EXTRA-TERRITORIAL OFFENCES

Safeguards for persons previously tried in Republic of Ireland

It is hereby declared that a person duly tried for an offence under the law of the Republic of Ireland which is also an extra-territorial offence is entitled to plead his acquittal or conviction in the trial in the Republic of Ireland as a bar in any proceedings in Northern Ireland for the extra-territorial offence.
