FINANCIAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE AGENCY

Borrowing by wholly owned subsidiaries

[F15] It shall be the duty of the Agency to secure that no wholly owned subsidiary of theirs borrows money otherwise than from the Agency or from another wholly owned subsidiary of theirs, except with the consent of the Secretary of State and the approval of the Treasury.]
