1976 CHAPTER 13

4 Executor's claim not to be excluded by relatives' claim: and vice versa.

A claim by the executor of a deceased person for damages under section 2 of this Act is not excluded by the making of a claim by a relative of the deceased for damages under section 1 of this Act; nor is a claim by a relative of a deceased person for damages under the said section 1 excluded by the making of a claim by the deceased's executor for damages under the said section $2; \ldots$
