1976 CHAPTER 16

3 Extent.

- (1) This Act extends to Northern Ireland.
- (2) This Act does not repeal any enactment so far as the enactment forms part of the law of a country outside the United Kingdom, but Her Majesty may by Order in Council provide that the repeal by this Act of any enactment specified in the Order shall on a date so specified extend to any of the Channel Islands^{F1}. . . .
