An Act to amend the law relating to premises for which special hours certificates may be granted under the Licensing Act 1964. [27th May 1976]

1 Repeal of section 76(5) of Licensing Act 1964. E+W

Subsection (5) of section 76 of the Licensing Act 1964 MI (which excludes any bar from premises in respect of which any special hours certificate may be granted under that Act) is hereby repealed.
