## 1976 CHAPTER 18

**E+W**

An Act to amend the law relating to premises for which special hours certificates may be granted under the Licensing Act 1964. [27th May 1976]

### 1 Repeal of section 76(5) of Licensing Act 1964. **E+W**

Subsection (5) of section 76 of the Licensing Act 1964 <sup>M1</sup> (which excludes any bar from premises in respect of which any special hours certificate may be granted under that Act) is hereby repealed.

### 2 Short title, citation and extent. **E+W**

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Licensing (Amendment) Act 1976.
- (2) The Licensing Acts 1964 and 1967 and this Act may be cited together as the Licensing Acts 1964 to 1976.
- (3) This Act does not extend to Scotland or Northern Ireland.
