OFFENCES

70 Children on premises in respect of which refreshment licence held

- (1) The holder of a refreshment licence in respect of any premises or his employee or agent shall not allow a person under 14 who is not accompanied by a person of 21 or over to be in the premises during the permitted hours, nor shall he allow a person under 14 to remain on the premises after eight in the evening, and if any person contravenes this section he shall be guilty of an offence.
- (2) No offence shall be committed under this section if the person under 14—
 - (a) is a child of the holder of the licence, or
 - (b) resides in the premises but is not employed there.
