Supplemental

16 Extent and application to the Crown.

- (1) Section 15 shall extend to Scotland, but otherwise this Act shall not extend to Scotland.
- (2) This Act, except section 15, extends to Northern Ireland.
- (3) This Act shall bind the Crown, but as regards the Crown's liability in tort shall not bind the Crown further than the Crown is made liable in tort by the ^{MI}Crown Proceedings Act 1947.
