Schedule 1 to the ^{M1} (which prescribes close seasons for deer of the species and descriptions therein mentioned) shall be read and have effect as if under the heading “Roe Deer (*Capreolus capreolus*)” in the said Schedule there were inserted the words—

“Buck 1st November to 31st March inclusive.”
