# Roe Deer (Close Seasons) Act 1977

## 1977 CHAPTER 4

An Act to Amend the Deer Act 1963 with respect to close seasons for roe deer. [17th March 1977]

**B**E IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Schedule 1 to the Deer Act 1963 (which prescribes close seasons for deer of the species and descriptions therein mentioned) shall be read and have effect as if under the heading "Roe Deer (Capreolus capreolus)" in the said Schedule there were inserted the words—

"Buck.....1st November to 31st March inclusive."

2.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Roe Deer (Close Seasons) Act 1977. Short title, and commencement.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1977.
