MINOR AND CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS

CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT 1967 (c. 80)

In section 44(5) (restrictions on magistrates' court's power to issue a warrant of commitment for a default in paying a sum adjudged to be paid by a conviction), for paragraph (b) substitute—

"(b) the court—

- (i) is satisfied that the default is due to the offender's wilful refusal or culpable neglect; and
- (ii) has considered or tried all other methods of enforcing payment of the sum and it appears to the court that they are inappropriate or unsuccessful. "
