MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS

117 Transfer of certain functions relating to courts to Lord Chancellor.

- (1) The functions heretofore exercisable by the Secretary of State under the enactments listed in subsection (2) and under any instrument made under any such enactment are hereby transferred to the Lord Chancellor.
- (2) The enactments referred to in subsection (1) are—
- (a) in the ^{M1}Administration of Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 1954, sections 11 and 14;
 - (b) the ^{M2}Coroners' Act (Northern Ireland) 1959;
 - (c) the ^{M3}County Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1959;
 - (d) the ^{M4}Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964 (except sections 25(1) and 46);
 - (e) F1
