Membership of HIS

- 2 (1) HIS is to consist of the following members—
- a person appointed by the Scottish Ministers to chair HIS;
 - the person appointed under paragraph 2(1)(a) of schedule 11 to the Public Services Reform (Scotland) Act 2010 (asp 8) to chair Social Care and Social Work Improvement Scotland; and
 - no fewer than 10 nor more than 13 other members appointed by the Scottish Ministers.
- (2) The Scottish Ministers may by order amend sub-paragraph (1)(c) by substituting for the minimum or maximum number of members for the time being specified there such other number as they think fit.
- (3) In appointing members, the Scottish Ministers are to have regard to the desirability of including—
- persons who have experience of, and have shown capacity and capability in, the provision of services provided under the health service or independent health care services;
 - persons who use, or have used services provided under the health service or independent health care services;
 - persons who have such other skills, knowledge or experience as the Scottish Ministers consider to be relevant in relation to the exercise of HIS's functions.]
