#### FINANCIAL PROVISIONS RELATING TO NHS TRUSTS]

##### Textual Amendments

##### *Limits on indebtedness*

- 3 (1) The aggregate of all sums borrowed by NHS trusts [<sup>F1</sup>which are required to provide services at or from] hospitals or other establishments or facilities which are situated in Scotland shall not exceed £500 million or such other sum not exceeding £1,000 million as may be specified by order made by the Secretary of State with the consent of the Treasury.
- (2) The reference in sub-paragraph (1) to sums borrowed does not include a reference to the initial loan of NHS trusts.
