Miscellaneous

102 State hospitals.

- (1) The Secretary of State may provide for the management of a state hospital either by a committee constituted under section [^{F1}91(2)] of the [^{F2}Mental Health (Scotland) Act 1984] or by a Health Board or the Agency to the extent that power to do so is delegated to the Board or Agency by the Secretary of State.
