#### SUPPLEMENTARY

*Pensions, etc.*

- 27 If the Secretary of State determines, with the approval of [<sup>F1</sup>the Treasury], that this paragraph shall apply in the case of an appointed member, the Secretary of State shall pay such pension, allowance or gratuity to or in respect of that member on his retirement or death or make that member such payments towards the provision of such a pension, allowance or gratuity as the Secretary of State may with the like approval determine.

- 28 Where a person ceases to be an appointed member otherwise than on his retirement or death and it appears to the Secretary of State that there are special circumstances which make it right for him to receive compensation, the Secretary of State may make him a payment of such amount as the Secretary of State may, with the approval of [<sup>F2</sup>the Treasury], determine.
